Power Trading Results in July 2018

In July 2018, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 65.9 TWh (July 2017: 53,5 TWh). The share of Order Book traded power was 28,6 TWh (July 2017: 28,7 TWh) which includes 4,3 TWh from German Power (July 2017: 4,4 TWh).

Electricity Certificates Trading Results in July 2018

In July 2018 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 1.12 million EI-Certs as compared to 0.74 million EI-Certs in July 2017. The share of Order Book traded EI-Certs was 0.04 million EI-Certs (July 2017: 0.01 million EI-Certs).

Carbon Trading Results in July 2018

In July 2018 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.17 million tonnes as compared to 0.02 million tonnes in July 2017.
