Power Trading Results in October 2018

In October 2018, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 70.2 TWh. The share of Order Book traded power was 27.7 TWh which includes 3.3 TWh from German Power.

Electricity Certificates Trading Results in October 2018

In October 2018 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 2.38 million El-Certs. The share of Order Book traded El-Certs was 0.18 million El-Certs.

Carbon Trading Results in October 2018

In October 2018 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.24 million tonnes.
