# **Power Trading Results in September 2018**

In September 2018, the total volume in power derivatives traded and cleared on Nasdaq Commodities amounted to 116.6 TWh (September 2017: 127.8 TWh). The share of Order Book traded power was 51.6 TWh (September 2017: 60.7 TWh) which includes 8.0 TWh from German Power (September 2017: 13.0 TWh).

# **Electricity Certificates Trading Results in September 2018**

In September 2018 the total volume of traded and cleared Electricity Certificates was 1.90 million El-Certs as compared to 1.54 million El-Certs in September 2017. The share of Order Book traded El-Certs was 0.06 million El-Certs (September 2017: 0.06 million El-Certs).

# **Carbon Trading Results in September 2018**

In September 2018 the total volume of traded and cleared EUAs was 0.25 million tonnes as compared to 0.31 million tonnes in September 2017.
